LOCATION

IEC Kanturk is located in the heart of the beautiful town of Kanturk in North Cork on a walled one hectare site. 




WHY JEC?

Students can take one of the many books from our library shelves and lose themselves in a story from many different genres and cultures.






School Restaurant

OUTSIDE THE CAMPUS

ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROGRAMMES

AGES: 10-17

Groups are invited to participate in an English Language programme organised to suit your group requirements. Stays can be arranged for a flexible duration – typically from 5 to 21 days. Placement Test

On the first day of school, students take a placement test to determine their level of English. The test examines their proficiency of the language and ensures that each child is placed in a class with other international students of similar ability. This allows them the best opportunity to learn effectively and improve their English at a pace they are comfortable with.

Active Learning

Our teachers use a variety of methods to engage students in our bright and spacious classrooms. As well as textbooks, students improve their English through group work and class activities. Individual attention is given to each child in order to assess and cultivate their individual needs.


ACTIVITIES

INTERNSHIPS & WORK EXPERIENCE

ERASMUS PLUS Internship Programme

We provide an internship service for students or groups wishing to avail of the Erasmus Plus funding or simply wishing to gain work experience in another European country. This programme is designed for EU students. Many students choose to combine a number of weeks English language tuition followed by an internship 4, 6, 8 weeks of duration and sometimes longer.

Students improve their practical knowledge of the English language and are placed in internships which relate to thier academic studies. Immersed in a host family or IEC Campus, students work and perform tasks on a daily basis providing them with a rich experience which can be added to their CV for future work opportunies.

A complete service from airport collection to the provision of accommodation and the placement in internships with companies is provided by Infinity English College. Ideally combined with the provision of a number of days or weeks of English on arrival interviews are then arranged with prospective companies. On successful placement further support is provided during the programme which includes a cultural itinerary and a 24 hour emergency number.

Work Study Programme

Our Work Study programmes are designed to meet the student's individual needs. We liaise with our agents and design a study tour for each student which may range from 1 to 2 weeks in duration.

These tours incorporate English language tuition that can include exam preparation such as IELTS, TOEIC or Trinity GESE Exams, Business English or English for Special Purposes. We supplement our English Language Programme with lectures covering the various aspects of Work Experience & Career Planning and arrange company visits. Suitable for EU students.

HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAMME

Infinity English College provides an enriching high school programme for students or groups wishing to be placed in a high school for a term or an academic year. This programme is personally monitored by Michelle Budden our Managing Director who regularly meets the High School students to ensure a successful experience and reports directly to agents on student welfare.

Participating students benefit from a hugely rewarding experience where they are immersed in a host family while attending a carefully selected Irish High School rich in culture and tradition. We carefully select high schools to partner with us who have a similar ethos to Infinity English College, high academic standards, and a positive and caring approach to student welfare.

Semester Choice

A student can choose to study in an Irish High School for:

- Full academic year...September to June
- 1 term...September to December

• 2 terms...September to March or January to June 12 weeks...September to May for 12 weeks

On submission of the completed application the process will commence with families and the school. We will carefully choose a high school based on the applicant profile.
